

13		Specific recommendation of the C.F. for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons.	:	Though the annual rainfall of this area is approximately 2450.00 mm, in the summer there is shortage of drinking water. This project will helpful to meet out the drinking water needs of local villagers. As well as the storage of Manekhind M. I. Scheme will be supplementary for meeting the demand of irrigation under Right Bank Canal & Left Bank Canal. Due to this skilled and unskilled employment to local labours will be available for long time. Hence this proposal of public utility project is recommended for acceptance.
