



Site Inspection Note

Sub: -Inspection of Project Site for Retail Outlet of BPCL at Vill. Madanpur, Gaya Proposed along NH-82, Gaya-Wazirganj_Hisua Road under Gaya Forest Range, Gaya Forest Division on 12th August, 2020 by Shri. S. Chandrasekar, IFS., Conservator of Forest, Gaya Forest Circle, Gaya, Bihar:

The instant project site proposed for diversion of forest land (linear Protected Forest) for making entry and exit passage path to the proposed BPCL Fuel Pump by the applicant dealer Shri. Shankar Singh, At-Katkachak Mor, Madanpur, P.O. Chand Chaura, P.S. Vishnupadh, District: Gaya - 823001, proposed site located at Vill. Madanpur, Thana no. 10, Khata no. 44, plot no. 40; District – Gaya located along NH-82, Gaya-Wazirganj_Hisua Road under Gaya Forest Range, Gaya Forest Division was inspected by the undersigned on 12th August, 2020 in the presence of the applicant, Shri. Shankar Singh; Divisional Forest Officer, Gaya Forest Division; Range Officer of Forest, Gaya Forest Range of the Gaya Forest Division.

The proposed project requires land for entry and exit of vehicles for the proposed BPCL retail outlet, which has to pass through the linear Protected Forest along the NH-82, Gaya-Wazirganj_Hisua Road, which was notified vide Department of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of Bihar's notification no. S. O. 400 dated 31.12.1996. The said forest land is bereft of any trees or vegetation and therefore will not disturb any wildlife, rather, there is no sign of presence of wildlife in the project area. However, there are free ranging Nilghais/Blue Bulls (*Boslephas tragocamelus*), Indian Jackal (*canis aureus*), etc. are found in the nearest natural forests but the location and nature of this instant project is not going to affect any wildlife in the area. No work for the establishment of the Fuel Pump Retail Outlet has been started in the proposed. There is no wildlife sanctuary located within 10 KMs from the location of the proposed project site. The proposed site is barest minimum required for the purpose under reference by the applicant. The undersigned concur with the report and recommendation of the concerned Deputy Conservator of Forest, Gaya Forest Division, Gaya.
