

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF
(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from National Highway Authority, Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Meerut, for diversion under (FCA-1980) of 11.1077 ha. of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages the use of forest land for "Forest Land Diversion proposal for 'Improvement and Up-gradation to 4-lane configuration of Meerut-Nazibabad section of NH-119 between Km 39+165 to Km 79+330 in the state of Uttar Pradesh' In district: Bijnor. (km 67+180 to km 79+330)

This site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by on dated 26.06.2021.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a protect forest measuring area 11.1077 ha. for "Forest Land Diversion proposal for 'Improvement and Up-gradation to 4-lane configuration of Meerut-Nazibabad section of NH-119 between Km 39+165 to Km 79+330 in the state of Uttar Pradesh' In district: Bijnor. (km 67+180 to km 79+330)
