9.	Condition of vegetation and type of forest in applied area.	The applied area is situated adjacent to and in continuum with Jamsol Reserve Forest which comes under Forest Type 3C/C2e(ii) Tropical Moist deciduous forests. Moist peninsular low level Sal(Source- Working Plan of Baripada Forest Division 2021-22 – 2030-31). Since the applied area is already in use the Eco value class of the applied area has been considered at par with the Jamsol RF which falls under, Eco value class -I and density 0.3 (open forest). The prevailing vegetation consist of <i>Tectona grandis</i>(Teak), <i>Acacia auriculiformis</i> (Acacia), <i>Simarouba glauca</i> (Simaruba), <i>Syzygium cumini</i> (Jamun), <i>Swietenia macrophylla</i> (Mehagani), <i>Atractomorpha similis</i> (Simili), <i>Gmelina arborea</i> (Gambhari) etc.			
10	Position of wild life in General	Wild fauna like Mongoose, Snakes, Lizards, Monkeys, reported in the proposed diversion of forest land. However movement of Elephant is reported in the Jamsol RF which is 0.5Km from the project area.

17	Suitability of the identified non-forest area for compensatory afforestation.	An area of 49.952 Ha of Govt. Forest land has been identified in village Beguniadiha and Kathasiris of Suliapada Tahasil Under Baripada Forest Division for raising Compensatory Afforestation. The aforesaid land has been jointly verified by the Officials of Revenue, Forest and Representative of User Agency. The area selected is suitable for raising CA Plantation.
18	Violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 if any and action taken thereof.	The forest area over 23.714ha was treated as Non-Forest as per Hal and record of Rights and whole area has been in use as per the requirement of the User Agency. Now the status of land stands as Forest Kissam as on 25/10/1980 and is required to be diverted for non forest use in compliance with the guideline F. No.8-78/1996-FC(pt) dt. 10.03.2015 read with F. No. 8-78/1996-FC(pt) dt. 09.03.2016 of MoEF & CC Govt. of India. The said proposed is therefore, submitted for necessary approval u/s 2(ii) FC Act.1980 taking the aforesaid facts into consideration.
