

FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, ASIFABAD (FAC) IN ASIFABAD DIVISION

On 27.07.2021 inspected the proposed diversion area for Laying of BT Road from "R/F PWD Road to Jhaduguda (PWD Road to Kishan Thanda) in compt No 525, Bheempur Block, Bhusimetta Beat, Kerameri Range in Jainoor Mandal in favour of District Panchyath Raj, Engineer (PIU), Komarambheem- Asifabad District along with concerned staff. As per the field re-verification of the above proposed diversion is passing through Reserve Forest, the details which are as follows.

The proposed diversion area is passing through Bheempur RF in Kerameri Range, the length is 3510 meters with a width of 7.50 meters and the area is 2.6325 ha required for diversion and remaining area passing through outside Reserve Forest i.e, length is 1967.77 mtrs with a width of 7.50 meters and the area is 1.4758 Ha.

After re-verification of proposed diversion road in the field, the deviation length of road is 57.77 meters is falling outside Reserve Forest that is in Kishan naik thanda village due to the user agency now demarcated Jandaguda to Kishan Nayak Thanda village ending school. Hence the length and area of diversion is justified as per the proposal of the User agency.

In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree is found, no protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area. The proposed area is not falling in National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant corridor, etc. There is no tree growth existing on the proposed diversion area.

The proposed area for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project. No violation against the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency. Hence it is recommended for considering the proposal.
