SITE INSPECTION REPORT

Sub: Diversion of Construction of 137.701 Kms of 400 KV Quad D/C Koppal PS- Narendra (New) Transmission Line passing through Forest land Sy No, 50/1 of Mannerala village and Sy No, 70/1, 70/2, 70/3, 71, 73 & 89 of Mavinaitagi village, Hanumasagar

Hobli, Kushtagi Taluk, Koppal District for a length of 1.644 Kms

(7.562 Ha) by Koppal-Narendra Transmission Limited.

I have inspected the proposed diversion area on 09.12.2022 for 7.562 Ha. in Sy No. 50/1 of Mannerala village and Sy Nos. 70/1, 70/2, 70/3, 71, 73 and 89 of Mavinaitagi village in Kushtagi taluk, Koppal District for laying of transmission line from Koppal to Narendra. The above shown Sy Nos. except Sy No. 89 fall within the Hanumasagar Reserve Forest. Sy No. 89 of Mavinaitagi village is a patta land and has been included by the User Agency by oversight as the private owner has left the land as it is without cultivating.

The proposed diversion area is part of a larger landscape primarily of the nature of scrub jungle with grasslands having presence of animals like wild hares, grey wolves, foxes, striped hyena, peacock, golden jackals and other ungulates. It is a unique habitat for the species like wolves and other intra-guild carnivores. Further the proposed diversion area is not part of any protected / archaeological / heritage site / defence establishment. The User Agency has demarcated the area with cement pillars at intervals of 20 m with gps readings. There is no violation of any provision under the Forest Conservation Act 1980 by the user agency.
