


**FIELD INSPECTION NOTE OF SRI C. SARAVANAN, IFS., CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS, ADILABAD CIRCLE, ADILABAD (FAC) FOR THE PROPOSAL OF PERMISSION IN AN AREA OF 189.6808 HA IN (i.e., 14.9638 HA ASIFABAD AND 168.4229 HA KAGAZNAGAR) DIVISIONS FOR LAYING OF NEW THIRD BG RAILWAY LINE ALONG THE EXISTING TRACKS WITHIN THE RAILWAY BOUNDARY BETWEEN MAKHUDI AND RECHINI ROAD RAILWAY STATIONS IN KOMRAMBHEEM ASIFABAD DISTRICT ON 26.09.2018.**

Proceeded to Kagaznagar Division on 26.09.2018 and reached Sirpur Range. I along with concerned staff have inspected the area proposed diversion pertaining to Tripling of BG Railway line between Kazipet and Balharsah passing through Kagaznagar Forest Division. Inspected the diversion areas in Compt. No. 92, RF Achelly, Sirpur Section of Sirpur Range. Test checked the Pillar No. B25 (N 19.45114 ; E 79.55277) and Pillar No. B14 (N 19.44461 ; 79.54357) in Peddabanda beat. Test checked the Tree Enumeration list. The species like Bamboo, Neem (*Azadirachta indica*), Rela (*Cassia fistula*) and Chinduga (*Albizia odoratissima*) are dominant in this location.



The area is falling in Tiger Corridor area and rich in other fauna like Spotted deer, Sambar, Neelgai and Four Horned Antelope.

It is necessary to provide cross over tunnels beneath the proposed Railway line for the benefit of wildlife movement especially along streams.
