## 13) Specific recommendation of DCF for acceptance or Other-wise of proposal with reasons.

The proposal is recommended for acceptance, as the proposed proposal submitted by, Executive Engineer, B &C North Dept. Z. P. Pune. for construction of road. Total Forest land required 0.963 ha. at village- Kusgaon Bk. Village- Gevhande (Apti) Tal. - Maval Dist. – Pune.

This proposed road will be useful for public / farmers of the nearby villagers & farmers also to promote tourist visiting Pavana Valley. P.A. has not started work on forest land & also on non-forest land. As this road is important to provide public utility & facility to local farmers & villages. There is no alternative other than proposed road alignment. The proposal is recommended for sanction under section 2 (ii) of F. C. Act 1980, for approval from Central Govt.
