## Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam on the proposal received from the User Agency i.e., Executive Engineer, Panchayat Raj Division, Paderu for diversion of 2.19 ha. forest land for construction of road from Luvvasingi to Alagam of G.Madugula Mandal on 24.05.2018.



Inspected the proposed area for diversion of 2.19 ha. for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Luvvasingi to Alagam of G.Madugula Mandal passing through Kokkirapalli RF & Akkajangi R.L. of Lothugedda Range on 24.05.2018 along with staff of Forest Department and Panchayat Raj Division, Paderu. As per the DGPS Survey the proposed road starts with GPS readings N:18.03448193, E.82.46945421 and ends at N:18.05635170, E.82.39815521. The proposed road width is 7.50 m., the total length of the road is 13,500 m. and the forest land required for diversion is 2.19 ha. in Compt. no.985 & 1125 of Kokkirapalli RF &

Akkajangi R.L. The density of the forest on the proposed road width is less as there is already an existing cart road/ pathway of width 4 m. There are no trees to be removed/ permitted to removed for laying the proposed road. The density of the forest in the nearby vicinity of the proposed road is about 0.5. The proposed road is very essential to tribal villages/ hamlets for their connectivity and essential services like medical facilities, education, marketing of agricultural

produce. In the inspected area the User agency did not carry out any work in violation of the provisions of FC Act, 1980 and other relevant acts. The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and there is no archeological heritage importance in this locality.
