Project Name: Diversion of forest land for construction of intake well & Raw water pumping main over an extent of 0.43 hectares in compartment No.354 & 355 of Sirvel Extension-II Reserve Forest, Nuthala North Beat, Rudravaram Range of Nandyal WL Division, Kurnool Circle, Nandyal District.

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, Public Health, Kurnool / Nandyal for diversion (under Forest Conservation Act, 1980) of 0.43 ha. of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The project proposal as stated by user agency envisages the use of 0.43 ha, forest land for laying of water supply pipeline and construction of intake well from Gandleru Reservoir on Telugu Ganga Canal to Allagadda town to meet the demand of drinking water for Allagadda Municipality in Nandyal District of Andhra Pradesh. The pipeline passes through reserve forest area from chainage 0.00 km to 3.415 kms length from Gandleru Reservoir to Allagadda - Ahobilam road of Allagadda Mandal, Nandyal District.

I have inspected the site on 21-05-2022. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by user agency is a reserved forest area of 0.43 ha. The site lies in Sirivel Extension-II Reserve Forest in compartment No.354 & 355 of Nuthala North Beat in Nuthala Section of Rudravaram Range. Type of forest 5A/C3 Dry deciduous forest and density 0.5, the predominant species in the area including Neem (Azadirachta indica), Narayepi (Hardwickia binata) Regu (Ziziphus zizyphus), Palvari (Wrightia tincforia) Kondagogu (Cochlospermum regiliosum) etc., and also includes various species of bushes, herbs, shrubs.

requirement of forest land as :: YES proposed by the user agency in Part-I is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project

Whether any rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna found in the area, if so the details thereof

:: Yes direct / indirect evidences of Tiger (Panthera tigris), Leopard (Panthera pardus), Sloth bear (Melursus ursinus) etc., are found and recorded from the area. The forest is a part of tiger corridor connecting Nagarjunasagar Srisailam Reserve (NSTR) in Nallamala hills with Sri Venkateswara National Park (SVNP) in Seshachalam hills. Hence, the biodiversity of the area is unique and rich. The movement of wild animals is regular in the area.




