The proposed area as per the enumeration, comprised of 1328 trees like Acacia, Syzigium cumini (Neral), Alstonia Scholaris (Kavalu), Terminalia Tomentosa (Matti), Mangifera indica (Mavu), Pterocarpus marsupium (Honne), Hopea wightiana (Haiga), Garcinia Indica (Murugalu), Aparosa lindlina (Challi), Ficus virens (Basari) and others. Seasonal water stream is found, which is about 222 mtrs away from the project area and Acacia plantation has been raised the number of seedling with in the proposed area is 1168 in the year 2021-22.

The proposed area for ordinary building Stone quarry does not affect any declared or notified monuments of historical, religious, archeological or recreation, The proposed area is at the distance of 5.8 km from the boundary of Sharavathi Valley LTM (Lion-Tailed Macaque) Sanctuary.
