The project for laying of 132 KV Double Circuit Transmission Line from Simdega to Monoharpur is in the interest of the State for meeting requirement of power essential for the growth and development of the state. The land category proposed to be diverted (3.70 ha) is Jungle Jhad and is in small patches along the proposed laying of transmission line bearing no forest cover or only open scrub. Some patches have sparse and scattered population of Sal and miscellaneous species. The proposed land is not prone to soil erosion as elaborated by DCF Porahat Forest Division. This project is recommended for acceptance.

**Inspection Note on the construction of 132 KV D/C Simdega-Manoharpur
Line through west Singhbhum District.**

Date of Inspection: - 27.04.2015 and 29.05.2016


Observations:-

The proposed construction of 132 KV D/C Simdega- Manoharpur line through West Singhbhum district involves diversion of Jungle Jhad land (3.70 ha) in Porahat Forest Division. Site inspection of various plots along the line of transmission revealed the proposed land involved does not bear any mature forest vegetation. While some plots have no standing trees or very or few scattered trees, the other plots bear only scrub vegetation. The tract involved is flat to slightly undulating and is not prone to soil erosion. Bare minimum vegetation will be cleared as under taken by the user agency (13.5 ha on either side of the central line). As such the project is in the interest of the state in terms of power requirement which is essential for the growth and development of West Singhbhum District in particular and the State of Jharkhand in general.
