The Executive Engineer, EHV, Construction Division, Kalwa at Airoli, Thane has submitted a proposal of 1.8947 ha of reserved forest, protected forest, private forest restored to owner for laying of 220 KV Nagothane (Kansai) substation to existing old 220 KV (Velshet) transmission line in Raigad district. Alibag: User Agency has erected two pole (area 0.0450 ha) with transmission line (0.1779 ha) total forest land used by agency is 0.2229ha; in the year 2006. This is a case of mistake of fact. The land in question was presumed as non forest land and hence the work was done on non forest land as well as private forest land. Detailed violation note is enclosed in the proposal on page no. 14A/
- 5. The forest area proposed for diversion belongs to eco-value class I and open forest.
- 6. The User Agency has submitted an undertaking to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed for diversion.
- 7. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag has certified that proposed project is not likely to affect any monuments site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance.
- 8. The User Agency has fulfilled the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Rights) Act 2006.
- 9. The proposed project is beyond 10 km from the boundary of protected area as certified by Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag.
- 10. The Deputy Conservator of Forests. Alibag has proposed double degraded forest area 4.00 ha from reserved forest comptt. No. 653 (Gut No. 23) of village Vandroshi, Tal. Sudhagad. Dist. Raigad: The Deputy Conservator of Forests has certified that it is suitable for afforestation & management purpose and also free from encroachment and other encumbrances.
- The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag has certified that the private area / non forest area which is to be acquired for the project is neither deemed Reserve Forest under the Maharashtra Private Forests (Acquisition) Act, 1975 nor it has been identified as "Forests" as envisaged in the interim order given by the Honorable Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996.
- 12. Three alternatives have been explored by the User Agency and the proposed alignment involves least forest area.
- 13. The Chief Conservator of Forests (T) Thanc and Deputy Conservator of Forests, Alibag have recommended the proposal for approval.

In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under section - 2 (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions -

i. The legal status of the land required will remain unchanged.

- ii. Compensatory afforestation will be raised at the cost of User Agency on double degraded forest land made available by the Forest Department.
- iii. Penal compensatory afforestation will be raised at the cost of the User Agency on 0.50 Ha. of degraded forest land made available by the Forest Department.
- iv. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the project.
- v. The User Agency will defray the cost of Net Present Value of 1.8947 Ha. of forest land as per the latest guideline of Government of India.
- vi. The User Agency will defray the additional / revised cost of Net Present Value of forest land as per the latest Guideline of Government of India.
- vii. All conditions as stipulated in the latest version of Annexure V of Guideline shall be strictly followed.
- viii. The User Agency shall compensate the private owner of forest lands in accordance with the prevalent laws, rules and guidelines.
- ix. Provisions of all Acts, Rules made thereunder and guidelines applicable to the project shall have to be strictly followed.

It is therefore requested that the Government of India may kindly be moved for diversion of 1.8947 ha forest land for laying of 220 KV Nagothane (Kansai) substation to existing old 220 KV (Velshet) transmission line in Raigad district under section 2(ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act. 1980.
