Recommendation by the Conservator of Forests for acceptance for the proposed two landing of Road Project for Garo Hills portion of Nongstoin to Tura via Rongjeng.

The proposed project in Garo Hills portion involves total forest area of 27.26 hectares passes through innumerable villages. It is therefore a vital infrastructure to boost the all round development of these villages and shall provide improved road connectivity to the important towns like Nongstoin, Williamnagar and Tura of Meghalaya.

The above forest area involved in proposed project is minimal when the importance of the project for overall development of the underdeveloped region in the country is considered. Furthermore, forest clearance for 27.26 hectares is required for the right of way only because the construction of road project does not require removal of any standing tree because it can be accommodated in blank strips of land along the both sides of the existing P.W.D. road. In this premise, the forest clearance for the project is recommended.
