- 13 Specific recommendations of the deputy conservator of forest for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reason;

The project under reference undertaken by Government of Maharashtra (MSRDC) is part of public infrastructure facility and essential for convenient, fast & safe travel. Hence the proposal is being recommended, subject to following conditions;

1. Every 1 km. Distance, appropriate signage's shall be place.
2. At every required place, underpass or culverts of appropriate size shall be kept for free movement of wild animals. At such places, Trap Cameras shall also be placed.
3. The project Proponent shall, at its own cost, provide three mobile Rescue Van to Forest Department.
4. The Project Proponent shall construct two Protection Huts (G+1) Model or as required by the Forest Department for wildlife protection & forest conservation.
5. Soil Moisture work should be done as per required or suggested by forest department.
