Site inspection report of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam for diversion of 2.48 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Nurmathi R&B Road to Pedajageeru village of G.Madugula Mandal on 14.11.2018.



Inspected the proposed area for diversion of 2.48 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Nurmathi R&B Road to Pedajageeru village of G.Madugula Mandal passing through Kokkirapalli RF of Lothugedda Range on 14.11.2018 along with Range staff and officials of the User agency i.e., Panchayat Raj Division, PIU, Visakhapatnam. As per the report of the Forest Range Officer, Lothugedda the proposed road is passing through Compt.no.978, 989, 990 & 988

in Kokkirapalli RF of Kokkirapalli Beat of Lothugedda Range. There is already an existing cart road/ pathway of width about 5 to 6m. The density of the forest in the vicinity is about 0.5. There are no trees existing in the proposed width of the Road.

The proposed road is recommended as it is essential to the people in tribal villages/ hamlets for their connectivity and essential services like medical facilities, education, marketing of agricultural produce etc. In the inspected area the User agency did not carry out any work in violation of the provisions of FC Act, 1980 and other relevant acts. The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and there is no archeological heritage importance in this locality.
