
FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF A.VENKATESHWARLU, DISTRICT FOREST OFFICER, MEDCHAL IN UPPAL RANGE OF MEDCHAL DIVISION.

Inspected the proposed forest area on 20.02.2021 for Diversion of forest land to an extent of 0.624 Ha in Medchal forest division under Medchal District- for Construction of six lane elevated corridor from Km7.950 (Uppal) to Km 14.200 (CPRI) of NH-163 (Uppal) to de-congest the Urban Limits of Hyderabad - Bhoopalapatnam Section on EPC mode in favour of Chief Engineer, Regional Officer, Hyderabad MoRTH, GoI. The Narapally - I RF of Uppal Range is notified U/s 15 of TS Forest Act, 1967. The proposed area of diversion in Narapally RF is entering in Compartment No.250 at 17.41300043 N, 78.61485368 E upto 17.41384395 N, 78.61776464 E (as shown in the map). The FRO Uppal has submitted the list of enumerated trees report in Narapally RF and its value in the proposed diverted area. The total No. of trees existing are 129 nos in the proposed area of diversion. The total value of the trees is Rs.53460/- as per the enumeration report. Accordingly ACA scheme (10 times the total trees to be felled i.e.1290 nos) is prepared for Rs.41.908 lakhs to be taken up in Medipally-II RF.

Chain link fencing proposed may be taken up by the user agency by providing a CRS well before handing over the area as the spotted deers are there in the Forest Block.

Further it is also found that there are no rare/endangered/unique species of Flora & Fauna found and no protected archeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area and it will not affect the existing forest.

Hence, it is recommended for diversion of forest land of 0.624 Ha
