SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF
CHIEF CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS, DINDIGUL CIRCLE, DINDIGUL.

1. The proposed site for diversion of 0.1756 ha. of Reserved Forest situated in Mayanur RF of Karur Division for providing drinking water supply to 274 rural habitations submitted by Executive Engineer, TWAD, Karur was inspected by me on 14.9.2020 with District Forest Officer, Karur and the Project Proponent represented by Assistant Executive Engineer, TWAD, Karur.

2. The proposed area is situated in Mayanur RF which is a Padugai RF of Cauvery river. The proposed alignment is within the existing right off way to a length of 390 metres. The proposed width of the project is 4 metres.

3. There is no standing tree available in this site. There is no spontaneous growth of trees.

4. The RF area required by the project proponent is bare minimum which is also essential for drinking water supply to the public of Thanthoni Union of Karur District covers 274 rural habitations.

5. The proposed area is not part of any protected area or Tiger Reserve and also does not fall under any migratory path of wild animals.
