

# SITE INSPECTION REPORT

(for the forest land to be diverted under FCA-1980)

A proposal has been received by this office from Project Implementation unit, Raebareilly, **National Highways Authority of India** for diversion (under FCA-1980) of **1.586 ha** of protected forest land for non forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of protected forest land to be diverted for Development of **4/6 lane Ayodhya Bypass of 67.572 kms (Package 1 Northern Ayodhya Bypass starting at km 112+540m ending at km 139+928 and package 2 Southern Ayodhya Bypass starting at km 112+54, ending at km 153+281 of NH-28) under NHDP Phase- VII in Ayodhya in the state of Uttar Pradesh.**

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated...18/08/2022

On inspection on the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is Protected Forest land having area **1.586 Ha.**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 of part-1 is unavoidable and is bare minimum required for the project.

Any rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna have not been found in the area.

Any protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is not located in the area.

The user agency has not violated the provisions of forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and no work has been started at the proposed area by the user agency.
