

## SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA-1980)

A proposal has been received by this office from **Territory Manager (Retail), Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. Territory BAREILLY (UP)** for diversion (Under FCA-1980) of **0.1870 Ha.** of protected forest land for non forestry purpose. The project envisages forest land **Proposed for Entry/Exit of IOCL Retail Outlet on Bareilly Shahjahanpur Road (NH-30/Old NH-24), In KM Stone No. 279 (CH: 278.543 RHS), At Gata No. 805, Village: Bakarganj, Tehsil-Faridpur, District: Bareilly (Uttar Pradesh).** The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 12.12.2022.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 0.1870 Ha.

The requirement of protected forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col.2 of part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
