### SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF (For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from T.Y. D.C.U. (NH), **Public Work Department, Gorakhpur** for Construction of Four lane R.O.B. At Ch. 85.500 Km. (Maniram) Railway Line Crossing of NH-29E stretch which is a part of Jungle Kaudia To Mohaddipur Road widening maintenance work in district Gorakhpur for Diversion under (Forest Conservation Act, 1980) of 0.19384 Hect. Protected forest land and no tree cutting is involved for Non Forestry Purpose. The project envisages the use of Forest Land for Construction of Four Lane R.O.B.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 11-02-19. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected Forest measuring 0.19384 ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Part-1 of Form-A is unavoidable and rarest minimum required for the project.
