As per letter number 2-2/2000 FC darted 16.10.2000 from ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of india for proposal involving less then 40 hectares of forest land, the site inspection report from DCF is required. And for proposal involving more the 40 hectares of forest land site inspection report from the conservator of forests is required.

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## The site inspection of the road conducted by the under signed on 16 th February 2019. The main observations are as follows:-

- 1- User agency has not taken into account the swell factor while calculating muck generation and therefore the volume of dumping sites have been under estimated.
  - User agency shall rectify the muck disposal plan accordingly.
- 2- A Scientific wild life management plan shall be prepared in future based on the final recommendations of the High Power Committee constituted by honorable supreme court. The report is in drafting stage and shall be submitted to MoEF Govt. in future.
- 3- The entire stretch of km 0.00 (Dharasu band) to 24.30 (Silikyara band) also traverses & cuts various small streams/tributaries of Bhagirathi river that have been given due importance by Hon'ble NGT in its various orders.
  - Accordingly the watershed treatment plan has been included in the proposal to treat upper & lower catchment of the affected streams.
- 4- The alignment has not been marked with Level pillars & Cutting pillars which poses a difficulty to identified the alignment in the field.
  - The user agency is required to construct the above stated pillars after 25 meters distance along the entire alignment.
