It meets the increasing demand of land for Small & Medium entrepreneurs around Bhubaneswar City. The Collector, Khordha has sanctioned lease of 79.394 Ac. of Non-Forest Land for establishment of New Industrial Area. The proposed project is a connecting road over a length of 582.99 mtr having width 30 mtr between new & old industrial area of IDCO in Gothapatana Village. Considering all aspects involved in forest diversion Socio-economic condition of the locality, keeping in view of industrial growth around Bhubaneswar diversion of 1.82 Ha. of forest land in the book of Revenue & Disaster Management Department, Government of Odisha in village Gothapatana of Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khordha District u/s 2 (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is recommended for construction of approach road between two industrial unit of IDCO subject to fulfillment of the following condition.</p> <p>The user agency and other concerned agencies need to take proactive measures to</p>

		prevent light & noise pollution. In order to cause to ensure the same a green belt plantation along both sides of the road would be taken up.
