- There is no alternate way except this area.
- No effect on flora & fauna on formation of road.
- This is very important road which connects to inter state transportation i.e., Maharashtra and Karnataka.
- The User agency should fell barest minimum of trees and should fell if require only.
- Side walls should be constructed to avoid soil erosion at one place.
- Removal of trees for the purpose of widening may add to the erosion factor which should also be taken care of. Hence a detailed soil conservation plan is proposed and enclosed. The proposal is recommended with the above conditions.
