

**Field Inspection Notes of Sri C. Saravanan, I.F.S., Conservator of Forests & Field Director
Project Tiger, Kawal Tiger Reserve Circle, Nirmal on 18-11-2017.**

Inspected the proposed Denotification areas in Reserve Forest Comt.No.842 & 851, Peddur Beat, Khanapur Reserve Forest of Kaddam Range, Khanapur Division of Nirmal District on 18-11-2017 for the propose of Rehabilitation of relocated Villages of Rampur and Maisampet from Core area of Kawal Tiger Reserve.



Proceeded to Kaddam Range and conducted site inspection in Comt.No.842 and 851 of Peddur beat, Khanapur Reserve Forest of Khanapur Division of Nirmal District.

The proposed diversion area is 112 Ha. in these two compartments. The proposed area consists of flora like *Tectona grandies*, *Butea monosperma*, *Azadisuchlz indica*, *Cassic fishtuk*. *Careya arborec*, *Madhuce lastifolic* and *Pterocarpus marsupium*. The vegetation is having canopy density of 0.1 - 0.3 and the forest type is Southern Tropical Dry Deciduous Teak and Miscellaneous forests.


The Staff have carried out enumeration of trees based on sample plots and followed stratified Random sampling method. Test checked the Sampling data. The tree enumeration data is enclosed along with proposals.

This area is having no rare / endangered / unique species of Flora and fauna. There are no protected Archaeological / Heritage / Defence establishment or any other monument in the proposed area of diversion.

This land is barest minimum for this project i.e., Rehabilitation of villages from Core areas of Tiger Reserve (Kawal). There are no other alternative except to denotify this patch of Reserved Forest for this propose and it is recommended for denotification under Forest Conservation Act and guidelines
