

Site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forest. (Col 11, Part II, Form-A, FCA,1980)

The portion of land proposed for construction of the Trevi Hospital at Langol area was inspected by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Central Forest Division on 28th August, 2021 and 18th November, 2020. The proposed site falls in the records of both the Revenue Department and the Forest Department. As per Forest records, the area falls within Compartment No. 3 of Lamdeng Block of the Langol Reserved Forest of Central Forest Division, Manipur and as per the records of Revenue Department, the area is covered by Dag No. 1194 and 1184 under village No. 91-Meitei Langol, Imphal West District.

The area is devoid of trees except at the boundary of the site where very few trees were found standing and as such felling of tree would be almost nil.

As mentioned earlier, the proposed site fall under Dag No. 1194 and Dag No. 1184 of Village No. 91, Meitei Langol and the area has also been termed as Government Khasland vide order dated 07.03.2017 passed by the Ld.Civil Judge, Senior Division, Imphal West in (i) Execution Case No.7 of 2004 and (2) Judicial Misc. Case No. 72 of 2017 Ref : O.S. No. 39/86/35/86/35/87/90/3/2003 in Shri. Manoharmayum Bimol Sharma (now deceased) by his L.Rs.-Versus-The Secretary, Indian Council of Agriculture Research (ICAR), Manipur Complex, Lamphelpat, Imphal.

The construction of Trevi Hospital in the area shall not displace any village settlement.

No protected archaeological/heritage site or other defence establishment or any other important monuments were found in the area to be diverted
