Inspection notes of the Divisional Forest Officer, Narsipatnam for diversion of 3.18 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Pachanapalli to Gemmili of <u>G.Madugla Mandal on 05.02.2019.</u>



Inspected the proposed area for diversion of 3.18 ha. forest land for formation and BT to the road including construction of culverts from Pachanapalli to Gemmili of G.Madugula Mandal passing through Krishnapuram of Chintapalli R.L. Range on 05.02.2019 along with Range staff and officials of the User agency i.e.,

Panchayat Raj Division, Paderu. Based on the reports of Forest Range Officer, Chintapalli the proposed road is passing through Compt. no.998 of Krishnapuram R.L in Tajangi Beat, Tajangi Section of Chintapalli Range with a diversion of 3.18 ha. There is already an existing cart road/ pathway of width about 5.00 to 6.00m. There are no trees to be removed/ permitted to removed for laying the proposed road. The density of the forest in the nearby vicinity of the proposed road is about 0.6.

The proposed road is recommended as it is essential to the people in tribal villages/ hamlets for their connectivity and essential services like medical facilities, education, marketing of agricultural produce etc. In the inspected area the User agency did not carry out any work in violation of the provisions of FC Act, 1980 and other relevant acts. The required forest area is unavoidable for the project and due to this project there is no threat to the local flora, fauna and there is no archeological heritage importance in this locality.
