

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

I have inspected the above forest area proposed for diversion for road leading to Indian Medical Association's IMAGE Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility on 04.01.2020. The proposed road is nearby the area recently diverted for IIT, Palakkad. The road is devoid of any trees and is being used by locals for many years. The total forest land utilization will be 0.2804 Ha. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is bare minimum for the purpose. No violation of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is noticed. Though the land is not an elephant corridor, elephant occasionally cross this road for crop raiding. Hence the proposal is recommended for diversion on condition that the road will be open for traffic only from 6 am to 6 pm. The road shall be secured with chain gate by Indian Medical Association to prevent misuse by quarries and local people.

RECOMMENDATION REPORT

The road is only approach road for IMAGE Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility and also few locals residing nearby. No tree felling is required but the diversion is only for Kutcha road to Pucca. Hence I recommend the diversion of 0.2804 Ha. of forest land for road purpose to IMAGE Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility, on condition that the road will be open for traffic only from 6 am to 6 pm. The road shall be secured with chain gate by Indian Medical Association to prevent misuse by quarries and local people.
