3.00 The proposal has been initiated by the Executive Engineer, MSRDC, Pune for seeking approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The User Agency has certified that the forest land admeasuring 2.40 ha is the minimum demand for the project. The project is for reconstruction of newly declared NH-204 Pandharpur-Sangola to Two lane with paved shoulders. It starts from Pandharpur at X- junction (with Kasadgaon railway road at RHS and Pandwad at LHS) and ends at the 3 legged junction with Solapur-Kolhapur Road (NH-204) at Patil chowk in Sangola with design length of 31+158 km (Km 48+375 to Km 79+533) to two lane with paved shoulders in the State of Maharashtra. The Forest land admeasuring 2.4 ha. is the minimum demand for the project. The details of the needs and benefits formthe Project area as follows:-

1. This road connectivity can reduce travel time, lower the cost of vehicle use, increase access to market, jobs education and health service and reduce transport costs for both freight and passengers. Thus helping development of industries in the area in the vicinity of the project.

- 4.9 and proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 4.800 double degraded forest land, in Gut No.19, Village-Nali, Taluka-Pandharpur, Division Solapur Dist. Solapur and it is contiguous, suitable for afforestation and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances (P/57).

5.00 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-

- 5.1 to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation (P/50).
- 5.2 to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed under diversion (P/64).

- The user agency has submitted the certificates of Collector, Solapur for 2.40 ha forest under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dweller's (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 issued vide letter No. 2018/RB/Desk-4/3-B/RR/1187, dated 26/11/2018 in prescribed format (From I) as per Government of India guidelines dated. 5/7/2013 (P/131).
- 5.4 Copy of the administrative approval accorded by Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (Project Zone-6) letter No. NH-12014/93/2016-MAH(P-6), dated 27/01/2017 (P/141)
- 5.5 Copy of the Technical approval accorded by Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (Project Zone-6) letter No. RW/NH/12014/93/2016-MAH, dated 25/01/2017 (P/143)
- 5.6 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Solapur Forest Division, Solapur and Chief Conservator of Forest (T), Pune have recommended the proposal for diversion of 2.40 ha. of forest land (P/5 to 10).
- 6.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: -
- 6.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 6.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

6.3 Compensatory Afforestaton:-

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department 4.800 double degraded forest land, in Gut No.19, Village-Nali, Taluka-Pandharpur, Division Solapur Dist. Solapur at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- 6.4 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

6.5 NPV:-

- a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 2.40 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of

the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.

- User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 6.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (http://parivesh.nic.in/).
- 6.8 User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.
- 6.9 Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
- 7.0 The user agency shall provide suitable under/over pass in Protected Area/ Forest Area as per recommendation of CWLW/NBWL/FAC/REC.
- 7.11 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 7.12 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 7.13 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 7.14 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 7.15 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 7.16 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
 - 7.17 It Shall be mandatory to provide underpass for safe crossing of wild animals:-
 - (a) The underpass shall have a minimum size of width 4.00 mt and Height 3.00 mt.
 - (b) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence, then no need to construct new underpass subject to existing structure nearly complying above mentioned dimensions, as suggested in (a) above.
 - (c) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence but as per engineering requirement, it is required to reconstruct then that structure shall comply with the minimum dimensions as suggested in (a) above.
 - (d) Interval between such underpasses shall not be more than 2.00 km
- 7.18 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.

- 7.19 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 7.20 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
