

SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF THE DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER, THRISSUR

I have inspected the proposed area on 13-01-2017. Executive Engineer, Electrical 13-01-2017

Division, Thrissur (East) has applied for seeking permission under Section 2 of Forest

Conservation Act 1980 to lay their proposed under ground cable through reserve forest for

222 meter length and 50 cm width and 1 m depth (total area 0.011 ha). No tree felling is

required to execute the work. Also this does not involve any endangered species of fauna

and flora. Forest land on either side consist of trees like *tectona grandis* and other species

The proposed area is almost linear stretch of reserve forest. On inspection the boundary

consolidation was observed to be completed, as cairns were intact along the border. State

Government has declared commitment to electrify all house holds in state by March 2017.

In this connection some applicants have registered from KSEB.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and is


the barest minimum for the electrification scheme. In view of above the proposal is
