The widening of Ambadi-Jawarla Road, MDR-94, chainage 00.00 km to chainage 6.850 km is passing through Nanded Forest Division, Nanded. The village of Jawarla Tal. Kinwat Dist. Nanded in the State of Maharashtra is adopted by Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra Shri. C. Vidyasagar Rao vide letter No. RB/DB/E-13016(6)2015/Adopton of village/356 datet. 19/05/2015. The stretch between Jawarla and kinwat is 38.00 Km and the existing

width is 3.65 mt. If this road is revived and asphalted the distance between Jawarla & Taluka headquarter of kinwat will reduce and shall be convenient access to tribal people to kinwat will be done. The Implementation of entire project will ensure fast and safe road traffic movement, reducing travel time. The proposed project also aims at creation of commercial nodes for multiple development mainly in industrial, commercial, agricultural, tourism sector resulting in to employment generation, capacity building as well as connectivity between industrial place. Due to the proposed project travel time will be saved. Fuel and maintenance of vehicles will be reduced. It will provide safe and faster transport and serve better connectivity in the region. Hence, meeting was convened on 7/9/2018 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra State with Principal Secretary (Tribal Development Department, Maharashtra), Principal Secretary (Public Works Department, Maharashtra), Secretary (Forests) Revenue & Forests and wherein the instructions has been given to take the work for improvement of Ambadi-Jawarla and complete the work by the end of December, 2018. Total length for which widening in forest area is required in 6.85 km. The Project is administratively approved by Government of India, Public Works Division, Mantralaya, Mumbai, Government Resolution vide No.RMR-2018/CR-151/Road-1,dt.19/10/2018 and Technically approved by Government of Maharashtra, Public Works Department, Nanded vide letter No. Technical/R-2, dt.9/11/2018. The site inspection report of Deputy Conservator of Forests, Nanded Forest Division, Nanded is enclosed on page no. 47.

- iv) The user agency will defray the additional / revised cost of Net Present Value of Forest land as per the latest Guideline of Government of India.
- v) The user agency will defray the cost of removal of 1283 trees in the proposed area. However, minimum number of trees will be felled.
- vi) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the proposal;
- vii) Ex-situ conservation of endemic species of flora/fauna lost/disturbed in the process of execution of the project may be ensured;
- viii) The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number toward and back bearing and distance from pillar to pillar.
- ix) All necessary precautions should be taken to protect the area from fire.
- x) The user agency will undertake comprehensive soil conservation measures at the project cost in consultation with the State Forest Department.
- xi) The user agency shall obtain the Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if required.
- xii) The user agency in consultation with the State Forest Department shall create and maintain alternate habitat/home for the avifauna, whose nesting trees are to be cleared in this project. Bird's nests artificially made out of eco-friendly material shall be used in the area, including forest area and human settlements, adjoining the forest area being diverted for the project;
- Afforestation to be done as per the norms of construction of roads along the road on either side or / and in the median shall be allocated for completion / maintenance by Forest Department / F.D.C.M. Ltd on a project basis.

- xiv) Space at the cost of project authority should be provided in form of Booths/Kiosk/ Hall etc, at roads indicated by Forest Department to facilitate setting up of Forest Check Nakas or Jan-Van-Dhan Stall/ Information Centers by the Forest Department.
- All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Acts, Rules and guidelines shall be complied with by the user agency.
