

SITE INSPECTION REPORT
(FOR THE FOREST LAND PROPOSED FOR DIVERSION UNDER FC ACT)

Project: Construction of 132 KV DC pare HEP to Lakhimpur Transmission line

The proposed area for diversion is to an extent of 10.381 under Harmuttu Range of Lakhimpur Division. The proposed site was inspected by the undersigned on 23-11-2021 along with the DFO, Lakhimpur Division, his RFO and Representative of User Agency (GPS Co-ordinate of the proposed transmission line is N 27°13/15.6// E 93°55/29.8//)

During the period of inspection, the proposed site, it is noticed that part of the area is being encroached. There are no archaeological/heritage site, defence establishment or any other important monument located in the proposed site for diversion. There are no rare/endangered known species of flora and fauna found in the proposed area. But elephant movements are occasionally found in the proposed area. The density of forest cover of the proposed area for diversion is found to be around 40-50% depending upon different patches of forests. The user agency has not violated any provision of the F.C.Act, 1980 and no work has been started. The proposed area is a partially encroached area and the requirement of the forest land proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and barest minimum. The proposed area is recommended for diversion with suggestion to take sufficient precautionary measure to protect valuable trees and to take sufficient measures to save wildlife, so that least damage is caused to the forest cover and Wild life in the light of the guidelines issued by the MOEF & CC.
