





However the user agency must ensure that during the construction phase no activity will be done by the staff and labors of the construction site in violation with the Assam Forest Regulation Act, Wildlife Protection Act and other relevant act in force at the time like hunting of wild animals and birds, felling of trees, collection of fuel wood etc. from the nearby forest area.
