

SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF.
(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, Banjar Divisin, HPPWD, Banjar for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 5.18 Ha of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for construction of Shanad to Srikot road Km 0/0 to 9/700. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 5.4.2018.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Undemarcated Protected forest measuring 5.18 Ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.

No rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna is found in the area.

No protected archaeological/heritage site/defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area.


(a) The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest(Conservation)Act,1980 and no work has been started without proper sanction.
