Alignment Drawing) approved by Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife)

Bengaluru vide letter No. PCCF(WL)/CR-26/2016-17, dated: 13-12-2017.

Hence, the proposal may be considered for clearance under Forest (Conservation)

Act 1980.
