This is being widening of existing road having 3.75 to 5.50 meter carriage width to 30.00 Meter ROW. Only minimum forest land is required which is unavoidable. No Realignment is proposed in forest area. 3. Widening of road will improve socio-economic Status of Hadgaon & Mudkhed tq of Nanded District. Most of the areas along this project is agriculture belt. Thus this will boost up agriculture growth in this area. 4. After construction of proposed road, to & fro movements of forest department officials vehicles should be exempted from payment of toll fees. 5.
