

SITE INSPECTION REPORT

(Highlighting facts about proposal as required under column-11 of Part-II)

1. A proposal has been received by this office from **Executive Engineer PWD (R&B)** regarding **Construction of Road from Ramakunda to Gool** for diversion of forest under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for non-forestry purposes. The project envisages diversion of **3.27 hectares** of Forest land. The site inspection of the spot involved in the proposal has been done by the undersigned on **16-02-2022**.
2. On inspection of the site, it is found that the project requires diversion of **3.27 ha** of Forest land falling in compartments **25/Ar, 26/Ar, 29/Ar** of Gool Block Gool Range Ramban Forest Division.
3. The requirement of the forest land and felling of trees as proposed by the User Agency in Col-2 Part-I is unavoidable and bare minimum required for the project.
4. No Rare/Endangered/Unique species of flora and fauna in the area during the visit.
5. Violation of the Act has been carried out by the User Agency details of which has been stopped and details uploaded under Part-II.
6. No protected/heritage site/defense establishment etc. is located along the current alignment.
7. 16 No. is coming under the alignment of the project which requires felling.
8. (b) **Specific recommendation for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal:** - Diversion of **3.27 ha** forest land for **Construction of Road from Ramakunda to Gool** is recommended for forest clearance under section-2 (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 in favour of User Agency **PWD (R&B) Ramban** with terms and conditions as mentioned by State Govt./MoEF & CC.
