I along with Forest Range Officer, Bellampally and concerned staff have inspected the area proposed for diversion for construction of four laning of NH 363 Hyderabad-Karimnagar – Chanda Road from Km 0.000 (Km 2511.900) to Km 94.602 (Km 324.000) – in favour of DGM (Tech.) & Project Director, NHAI, PIU Nirmal on 07.09.2018. The proposed National Highway is passing through Compt No.306/2 Tandur Ext. Reserve Forest block and Compt.No.308 Madaram Reserve Forest block with a length of 255 Mtrs and 753 Mtrs respectively in Bellampally Range of Bellampally division.





The total area required for diversion in Bellampally division for construction of four laning of NH 363 Hyderabad-Karimnagar –Chanda Road from Km 0.000 (Km 2511.900) to Km 94.602 (Km 324.000) is **3.517 Ha.**

In the proposed area for diversion, no unique tree species, protected archaeological, Heritage site, defense establishment or any other important monument are found.

The area proposed for diversion is having different types of vegetation, with a density varying from 0.1 to 0.2.

The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project.

No work in violation of the Forest Conservation Act 1980 is carried out by the User Agency.
