Site Inspection Report

Inspection Note on the Proposal for diversion of 0.2 ha of forest land by Bio Resource Development centre, behind the existing centre (Building).

The inspection was carried on in the field on Friday the 14th April, 2022 along with the Range Forest Officer I/C Shillong south range.

The project proponent has proposed for enlarging/expansion of 0.2 hac of Forest land at Upper Shillong Protected Forest for Skill Development and Capacity Building of Traditional Healers of Meghalaya. During inspection it was observed that there are a total no. of 55 nos. of trees to be felled, of which there are 04 nos. of trees to be felled of girth below 60 cm and 51 nos. of trees to be felled of girth above 60 cm.

No violation has taken place as the proposed area has not broken.

Due to the propose Shillong-Dawki road expansion along NH-40, a portion of land of Bio Resources Development Centre is being diverted also as the proposal is of great public importance for promoting the Indigenous system of medicine in Meghalaya, the traditional healers and also encourage the youth of the state to involve themselves in this particular field of services. Hence the proposal is recommended for acceptance.
