

Site Inspection Report

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

5.1 A Proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, PWD Karanprayag, (under FCA 1980) of 2.015ha of Forest Land (1.110 ha Reserve Forest, 0.747 ha civil land, 0.158 ha Van Panchayat) for non-forestry purpose. The Project envisages transfer of forest land for Extention of Umatta Barsali Mouna Motor road to Bairfala Kandai Motor Road (Length 5.00Km) under PWD. The Site Inspection done by Dfo Badrinath forest divison on dated..05/08/2021

5.2 On Inspection of the site, It is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest area measuring 2.015ha of Forest Land (1.110 ha Reserve Forest, 0.747 ha civil land and 0.158ha Van Panchayat).
