If so recommended area item wise with details of alternatives examined	<p>The user agency has proposed the length of road is 6408.22 Km and width is 9 Mtrs and the diversion area as 5.7674 Ha in Adilabad Division. The proposed widening of existing road is passing through interior forest area and the surrounding areas covering with good flora and fauna.</p> <p>It is observed that the length of the road inside the RF is 6.59856 KM instead of 6.40822 Km proposed by the User agency. This route has no alternatives and the road width of 9 Mtrs proposed by the User agency is not necessary as the vehicular traffic is negligible and hence in view of protection of forest and requirement of up gradation of road, a width of 7.50 Mtrs is recommended instead of 9 Mtrs as proposed by the User agency and the diversion area reduced to 4.9489 Ha. As per the justification given by user agency and the field conditions, the barest minimum and unavoidable area for the project is 4.9489 Ha.</p>

The road connectivity improves the standard of life of the interior tribes and facilitates to transport agricultural produce to the nearest market centres.</p> <p>Thus, the area i.e., 4.9489 Ha for diversion towards upgradation and formation of road for BT road with reduced width of 7.50 meters over a length of 6.59856 Km, which is falling in Sathnala Reserve Forest in Adilabad division, is recommended which is already violated by the User Agency considering all the aspects mentioned in the proposal and field conditions.</p>
