The green belt will be created through the amount realized from the user agency as Compensatory afforestation work and it will help in the increasing green cover. The proposed area involves diversion of 0.5612 ha in Gaya Forest Division, Gaya. This is the barest minimum of forest land required for the instant project and has no other alternative to bye-pass. Diversion of these forest land areas for this project (non forestry activity) may not much affect the local flora of the area. The User Agency has not violated the prescribed provisions of the Act. In the light of the above mentioned facts and keeping the fact that Gaya Districts are fall under the Naxal Affect area and as per the prescribed provisions I recommend positively for the approval of this instant proposal with penal provisions. Therefore this instant proposal for diversion of forest land may be approved with necessary conditions and directions.
