Specific recommendation of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reason.

The transit compound and convoy ground at Sessa measuring 2.12 ha. is important to Indian army to regulate crossing of convoys and would act as an transit accommodation camp with logistic, medical & communication facilities. The camp would provide the basic minimum facilities/amenities to the transients during road blocks & provide adequate space for a Regiment to carry out counter insurgency operation in Foothills areas, within West Kameng District. This can also be used for other essential operational purposes by the Indian Army.
