**SITE INSPECTION REPORT OF DIVISIONAL FOREST OFFICER, GOLAGHAT
DIVISION, GOLAGHAT**

I, Sri S.K Thakuria, AFS, Divisional Forest Officer, Golaghat Division, Golaghat have re-inspected the proposed diversion site of drilling location **KHDE** vide proposal No. **FP/AS/MIN/22288/2016** for diversion of forest land for Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Ltd. Jorhat, Assam in Rengma Reserve Forest. The proposed diversion site is open reserve forest where the density of the forest is NIL and will thereby nullify the felling of trees. The area has no importance from protected archaeological point of view and there is no heritage site, defence establishment or any other important monument along the area proposed for diversion.

This proposed diversion site was earlier inspected during the year 22.01.2018 by my predecessor as part of the earlier proposal concerning diversion area of 2.28 Ha. However, the earlier proposed area of 2.28 Ha is now reduced and revised by the User Agency to 2.22 Ha and hence the re-inspection was conducted.

The proposed diversion area of **2.22 ha.** is

- i) Within Rengma Reserve Forest.
- ii) Open forest devoid of trees.
- iii) Located at an aerial distance of 14.31 kms from the nearest wildlife sanctuary i.e. Nambor- Doigrung Wildlife Sanctuary.
