SITE INSPECTION REPORT BY DCF

Date of field inspection- 07-10-2017

The proposed forest land for diversion is crossing through two P.F. namely Tonapathar & Katsakara and crosses SH 22 Sultanganj-Katoria road at one place which is notified as protected forest by Government of Bihar vide Notification no.- C/F-1709/56-384 R dt 1st February 1956 for Tonapathar P.F. & Notification No.C/F-17035/55-2439 R dt 9th August 1955 for Katsakara P.F. and notification no-921-E dt-28-08-1997 for Sultanganj Katoria road. The proposed forest area for diversion is 0.459 hectare. As per enquiry report of forest officials and information provided by user agency, there is no record of any protected archaeological/ heritage site/ defence establishment or any other important monument is located in the area. Total 20 trees of Acacia, Shisham, Mahua, Gulmohar, Semal, Palas, Karanj etc. mainly in form of linear plantation along the road side as well as in Protected forest patch is going to be fully removed for implementation of the project. The user agency has not violated the prescribed provisions of the Forest Conservation Act and Indian Forest Act. This is the bare minimum forest land required for the project and unavoidable.
