**JOINT INSPECTION OF VIOLATION ROAD PARECH, DAFAWAG TO
BATHYAR-KARECH 0/0 TO 4/200 KM (FP/HP/ROAD/21589/2016 IN
COMPLIANCE OF GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION NO. FFE-B-F (3)-31/2012
DATED 30.05.2014.**

In compliance to the above referred notification joint inspection of the road Parech, Dafawag-Bathyar-Karech link road (2.2973) was carried out on 25.05.2022 in compliance to High Court order in CWP No. 5600 of 2012, CWP No. 9797 of 2012 and CoPC No. 56 of 2009.

The entire road length 0/0 to 4.2 Km about 3 meters is already constructed and about 3.5 Km four wheeler vehicles plying. This road is constructed by Gram Panchyat through villagers with funding from BDO Totu. The proposal also involves 0.4441 ha. private land. The road passes through three villages Parech, Dafawag, Bathyar and Karech, User Agency has reported that violation has been done during 2007 and 0.1677 ha. land is involved in violation. There is no record of trees damaged to be involved in the violation.

The entire road length is to be reconstructed with 5-7 meter width and the road portion remaining 500 meter is to be constructed properly with side drains and retaining walls where ever required. A large number of trees (182) of V and IV class (Mainly Ban) (94) are coming in the road alignments which are located on spot. User agency is advised to save as much as trees as possible and also transplant V class Ban and Deodar trees in the adjoining forest land.

Dumping site as proposed, retaining wall and side drains are required to be constructed and to save the ecology specially Ban, Oak and Deodar trees, User agency is advised to transplant the trees in the adjoining forest land.
