The violation proposal recommended for acceptance, as the proposed area is barest minimum subject to condition of installation 20 nos. sign boards with information of wildlife area, slow passage for vehicle should be provided. Tall avenue plantation along the 1130 Mtr. forest diverted highway length should be provided. It will help in reduction of road kills and public awareness about forest and wildlife.
