Specific Recommendation of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Maharashtra State (Head of Forest Force) with regards to acceptance or otherwise of the proposal supported by reasons.

1) The proposal for diversion of 4.99 ha. Zudpi Jungle Forest land at Chichpalli in Survey No.6/1 of Chichpalli Range in Chandrapur Forest Division has been initiated by Divisional Forest Officer, Chandrapur for establishment of Vocational Bamboo Research & Training Center for skill development and self employment of local tribal & burad community. The Project has been approved by Government of Maharashtra, vide letter No.EST-2013/C.R.64/Part-2/F-9, dt.4/12/2014. The User Agency is Divisional Forest Officer, Chandrapur Division, Chandrapur.

As non forest land is not available for establishment of Vocational Bamboo Research & Training Centre near Chichapalli, Dist. Chandrapur, therefore forest land has been selected in consultation with Revenue Department, since the Zudpi Jungle land involved is under the control of Revenue Department. The selected site is near Chandrapur city having developed infrastructural facilities, like road, water, electricity etc. The longitude & latitude of project is A 20:00:13.185 & 79:28.44:147 B 20:00:07.680 & 79:28:44.150 C 20:00:07.57.4 & 79:28:43.297 D 20:00:03.950 & 79:28:43.570 E 20:00:03.428 & 79:28:39.033 F 19:59:59.369 & 79:28:38.672 G 19:59:58.668 & 79:28:33.317 H 20:00:01.836 & 79:28:39.165 I 20:00:07.765 & 79:28:38.787 respectively.

Skill development of local tribals, burads & other artisans through vocational training in bamboo articles, handicrafts, furniture making etc. will increase employment potential in the area. Besides this technical, field & ministerial staff will be appointed for smooth running of the institute.

- 2) Divisional Forest Officer, Chandrapur Division is of the opinion that no suitable alternate non forest land is available other than the proposed forest area of 4.99 ha. of Tal. Chandrapur Dist. Chandrapur which is the barest minimum.
- 3) Density of forest is below 0.4 (open forest).

- ii) The Project Authority will defray the cost of Net Present Value of 4.99 ha, of forest land as per the latest Guideline of Government of India.
- iii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the project.
- iv) The proposed diversion of forest land for the project will be confined to 4.99 ha. only.
- V) As the project area is within 8.75 km of the boundary of Protected Area (Tadoba Andhari Tiger Reserve boundary), the user agency will have to seek the permission of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal with respect to order dated 13/1/2014 in application No. 135 (THC)/2013 [Shobhatai Phadanvis Vs State of Maharashtra] before grant of work permission or diversion by the State Government.
- vi) It will be the responsibility of the User Agency to ensure that the laborers/staff engaged in other activity do not damage surrounding forest flora and fauna.
- vii) The User Agency will defray the cost of felling/removal of required trees. However minimum number of trees will be felled, and the number of trees to be felled should not be more than 50 trees/per hectare.
- viii) Provision of all relevant Acts, Rules made there under and guidelines applicable to the project shall have to be strictly followed.
