FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF M. VIJAY KUMAR, FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, UTNOOR (FDPT) ON DIVERSION OF 0.3999 Ha FOREST LAND IN BIRSAIPET (KTR) RANGE OF UTNOOR (FDPT) DIVISION FOR LAYING OF OPTICAL FIBER CABLE BY RELIANCE JIO INFOCOMM LTD ON 13.08.2018.

I along with Forest Range Officer concerned and Range staff of Birsaipet Range have inspected proposed diversion of Forest Land for laying of Optical Fiber Cable Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd.(RJIL), in Utnoor (FDPT) Division. The proposed area is falling in Kawal Reserve Forest blocks and Narsapur, Danthanpally, Yellaguda, Bhupet and Kolamguda beats of Birsaipet (KTR) Range along the R&B road. The length of road passing in forest is 11.800 KM (11800 Mts) and width is 0.50 Mts. The proposed area falling in Core area of Kawal Tiger Reserve. The area required by the user agency is as follows.



There are no protected Archaeological/ Heritage site/Defence establishment or any other important monument in the forest area proposed for diversion.

Thus this laying of Optical Fiber Cable by Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd.(RJIL), is recommended considering all the aspects mentioned in the proposal and field conditions.
