

FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF Sri. V.TIRUMAL RAO, FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, KHANAPUR ON DIVERSION OF 0.5695 Ha OF FOREST LAND IN KHANAPUR DIVISION FOR LAYING OF OPTICAL FIBER CABLE IN FAVOUR OF M/s RELIANCE JIOINFOCOMM LTD ON 17.05.2019.

I along with the Forest Range Officer, Udumpur and concerned Range staff of Udumpur Range inspected the proposed area for diversion of Forest Land for laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road within the existing Right of Way under Khanapur Division in favour of Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd., on 17.05.2019. The proposed area is falling in Udumpur Range of Khanapur division, Kawal Reserve Forest block along the R&B road. The length of the road passing in forest is 14236.44 Meters, width is 0.40 Meters and total extent of Forest area proposed for diversion is 0.5695 Ha. The proposed area is falling in Core area of Kawal Tiger Reserve.

During the field inspection, it is noticed that, the proposed area alignment for diversion is passing within the right of way of existing Roads and no tree growth is existing, hence no cutting of trees is required.






The said proposed area for diversion is falling in Kawal Tiger Reserve. There are no rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora and fauna found in the forest area proposed for diversion. There are no protected Archaeological/ Heritage site/ Defence establishment or any other important monument in the forest area proposed for diversion.

Thus this laying of Optical Fiber Cable by M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd., is recommended considering all the aspects mentioned in the proposal and field conditions.
